The Federal Court of Australia provides access to judgements through a variety of mediums. The Internet has enabled the Court to provide access to its judgments in full text, and judgment summaries in video/audio format on its website.

The Construction Site Multimedia (TCS) and Fastcast Networks (FCN) established our video streaming infrastructure for judgment summaries.

With the advice and technical expertise of personnel from TCS, the Federal Court of Australia became the first Australian court to broadcast a live streaming video of a judgment summary over the Internet. This was a very high profile case, which concerned the ownership of film rights to the 1956 Melbourne Olympic Games.

Their first show for Red Bull TV, "A Date with the Strait", follows three paddle boarders and a guide as they attempt to paddle across the Bass Strait from the Australian mainland to Tasmania.
